## Zachary Littleton youth minister

Dear FBCA Family,

It was suggested to me that I share my personal testimony with you all. The youth have already heard some of this information, but many of you have not. When I was in middle school my parents and I began attending a church. I remember hearing a sermon and for the first time, really listening. Unfortunately, the first sermon that I truly listened to was a poor one. I soon found myself down a path of atheistic belief. I became angry and temperamental and devoted myself to finding what I believed was "truth." By my sophomore year in high school, I began learning music and developing a love for it. A friend invited me to church so that his youth minister could teach me how to play my instrument better. I attended church for months and thanks to that youth minister's determination, I finally accepted the real "truth." It took this part-time (basically volunteer) youth minister four months, three nights a week for three hours each night of answering questions that I had and developing a relationship of trust and respect with me to convince me of the truth of the gospel. I didn't have an emotional conversion, but I began to feel the Spirit move in my life, changing me into someone new. In discipleship, course after course, teacher after teacher, God called me to ministry. I cannot imagine how my life would've turned out without my Christian friend's bravery to ask an outspoken atheist to attend church, or the unbelievable determination of the youth minister who gained my respect and trust. Because of my shame, my faith became very real. My hope is that I might be capable of imitating this level of sacrificial love for another student.
