Philippians 2:3-8, 12-13

Sermon in a Sentence: *What we believe ought to be shaping our behavior; let God empower you to set aside your pride and serve each other.*

These verses highlight Christian Doctrine and Christian Duty.

2:3-8 In the exact glorious nature of God, Jesus put on the exact ordinary nature of a servant and died in a most malicious way.

V6 Who Jesus Is- "He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact representation of His being" Hebrews 1:3.

Vv7-8 What Jesus Did- He died on a cross identifying with even the lowest of humanity.

2:12-13 In light of Christ's attitude, don't allow quarreling and complaining to rip apart your unity.

4:2 suggests that two prominent women in the church were not agreeing on something.

Is this how Jesus obeyed His assignment? Did He complain or argue out of selfish ambition?
