# Zachary Littleton youth minister

Dear FBCA Family,

It feels like February just flew by so quickly. As we move into March, let me tell you about our next fundraiser:

This fundraiser is called the Silent Sunday Fundraiser. Each youth will be responsible for going out to their families, teachers, and friends to gather sponsors for this fundraiser. On March 14th, each youth will face the most difficult challenge of their year, being silent for a whole 8 hours. For some, this task is simple. If they just fall asleep, they won't talk (except when they talk in their sleep). For others, this task is difficult. NO talking for 8 hours straight seems like an eternity to some people. But, to torture them a bit more, if they raise a total of \$20 or more on this fundraiser, they also lose all communication devices (cell phones, computers, etc.) The pure agony on their faces when I take their phones away is worth the \$20 alone, and I have been known to pay for a few youths myself just to make them squirm.

Now, this fundraiser is specifically designed to be an outside of the church plea, however, if a youth comes to you with those puppy dog eyes and asks you to donate to their fundraiser, I won't blame you if you cannot resist. The pledge options are per hour or flat rate. If you donate per hour, it would be however much you choose (\$2 per hour would be \$16 for 8 hours if they make it the whole 8 hours). The flat rate pledge is a flat rate amount of your choice (\$20 for all 8 hours if they make it the whole 8 hours). We do hold them accountable to their pledges and if they fail, you are under no obligation to hold "your end of the bargain," though most people are forgiving.

Each youth is responsible for finding their own pledges and if any youth receive over the amount of their camps (as some have done in the past) the remainder will be split evenly between all youths who are still raising funds. If a youth asks for your pledge, please do not feel obligated on this fundraiser (it is intended to reach outside of the church); however, some youths will still reach from within because you are their friends and family.
