This story really begins back in 8:22-25 as the disciples go for a boat ride with Jesus. Knowing the poor condition of the demoniac in Gerasa, Jesus mercifully goes to him to help him (a key theme in Luke's Gospel is Jesus helping the helpless). On the way a storm arose on the lake to test the faith of the disciples. Obviously, their faith is still in the incubation phase. So, what kind of faith is Jesus looking for?
