Volunteers vs. Servants: I often hear in the church that we need more volunteers. I understand. Yet, I don't see volunteers in the early church according to Scripture. The little information we have in Acts seems to articulate the volunteers as Servants or Workers. Volunteer sounds so secular to me. Volunteers come and go to assist special work-related events. Yet, Jesus indicates that we are followers, committed to Kingdom work in our church and community. The early church was made up of people who committed themselves to Jesus then to each other. Read Acts 4 and 5 and notice the sacrifice of Barnabas. Then, notice his antithesis, Ananias then his wife Saphira! Barnabas gave to the church, the other two took from the church. When Ananias and Saphira were found out and disciplined, "great fear came upon the whole church and upon those who heard these things." There was a sense of awe among the believers, and respect from the community! You can read for yourself how God blessed the church by signs and wonders and left the community in absolute fear of God.

We have a real need for *Servant/Workers* at FBCA. We do not need Volunteers; we need committed Workers. I sincerely believe the way to find the work God has for you in His church is to discover your *Spiritual Gift*. Every Christian has a spiritual gift; they are dynamic according to the needs of your church. I have a Spiritual Gift Survey that has proven helpful over the years. Would you like one? Just ask and I will help. Discover your gift and let's get to work for God. Volunteers vs. Servants? Which one are you? Please let me know when you are ready to serve.

Wednesday Nights at FBCA: I began a new series in 1 Corinthians in our Wednesday night Bible Study in the sanctuary. # Zachary Littleton youth minister

Dear FBCA Family,

We had a great time at our DNOW event in February. We had 20 students attend and I had 10 adult workers helping. I want to thank my adult volunteers for being so generous with your time and energy. You made this event successful.

This month we are preparing for our annual Silent Sunday Youth Fundraiser on March 6<sup>th</sup>. Each youth will be responsible for going out to their families, teachers, and friends to gather sponsors for this fundraiser. The youth will face the most difficult challenge of their year... being silent for 8 hours straight. For some, this task seems simple. If they just fall asleep, they won't talk (except when they talk in their sleep). For others, they know that this task is difficult. NO talking for 8 hours straight seems like an eternity to some people. But, to torture them a bit more, if they raise a total of \$100 or more on this fundraiser, they also lose all communication devices (cell phones, computers, etc.) The pure agony on their faces when I take their phones away is worth the \$100 alone, and I have been known to pay for a few youths myself just to make them squirm. Now, when a youth comes to you with those puppy dog eyes and asks you to donate to their fundraiser (I won't blame you if you cannot resist), then you can do as follows:

The pledge options are per hour or flat rate. If you donate per hour, it would be however much you choose (\$2 per hour would be \$16 for 8 hours if they make it the whole 8 hours). The flat rate pledge is a flat rate amount of your choice (\$20 for all 8 hours if they make it the whole 8 hours). We do hold them accountable to their pledges and if they fail, you are under no obligation to hold "your end of the bargain," though most people are forgiving and merciful. Each youth is responsible for finding their own pledges and if any youth receive over the amount of their camps (as some have done in the past) the remainder will be split evenly between all youths who are still raising funds.
