"But this people has a stubborn and rebellious heart." These words came from God to Jeremiah the Prophet (Jeremiah 5:23). Yet, I find them to be quite timely for the 21 Century. On Thursday this week I pulled up to the Mineola Primary building dropping off my grandson Camden for school. In the aftermath of the Uvalde tragedy, I felt the overwhelming need to kiss Camden on the head. I said, "Have a good day little buddy." The uniformed and fully armed Mineola Policeman standing close by brought the lugubrious reality home that there are some very deranged, desperately wicked people lurking in our midst. All of us are affected by these tragedies, some directly others indirectly. Jeremiah is referred to as the Weeping Prophet. Not because he couldn't man-up, but because his heart was broken that people were not turning to God. The 6th C BC culture did not differ much from ours. Jeremiah preached against stubborn believers, the sacrifice of innocent children, sexual sins among God's people, and immoral government leaders leading the people further into rebellion against God's commands. Don't lose hope! "Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted, " is Jesus' promise to those who mourn over their sin and return to God (Matthew 5:4). Don't blame God when human tragedy strikes. Our hearts are desperately wicked above all else. Humbly ask God to help you understand. Rely on the Holy Spirit in prayer. He "helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words" (Romans 8:26).


