Verse of the Month: *“I entreat Euodia and I entreat Syntyche to agree in the Lord.” Philippians 4:2.* While I am honored that God brought thirty new members to the church, my pastoral gut tells me to be careful. 2023 might be the hardest year we have had in a while. Early in their careers, Audrey Hepburn and Marlon Brando were seated next to each other at an Actors Guild luncheon. When they sat down, Hepburn uttered a shy “Hello” but Brando did not say a word the entire meal. For the next 40 years Hepburn believed that Brando shunned her. Her son Ted explained how Brando learned of the hurt and sent her a letter while she was in the hospital towards the end of her life. He said he was speechless in her presence that day because he was in absolute awe of her. He could not think of a single thing to say to her. She was shy of him, and he was in awe of her. Yet, a simple misunderstanding fueled four decades of resentment. Their story is sadly similar to many church members in conflict with one another long overdue for resolution. Paul wrote to the Philippian church in chapter 4 pleading with two prominent women in the church to resolve their conflict. We must be careful to communicate with each other, bear with each other, and resolve conflict quickly when it happens. Three elements are involved in conflict resolution: a. A Confession of Sin, b. Forgiveness, and c. A New Relationship. *“Forgiveness is not a shock treatment that instantly wipes out our memory of the recent past.” Jay Adams-*

Dear FBCA Family,

It’s 2023 and the youth are gearing up for camps this summer. As usual, we are beginning our fundraisers with the Wall-O-Money (WOM) fundraiser which will begin at the end of January. The WOM fundraiser is our largest fundraiser that spans from January to May. The WOM consists of envelopes with numbers ranging from 1-100. Inside each envelope are written thank-you notes from our amazing youth, and a schedule for our camps in hopes that you will pray for us. When you take an envelope off the wall, we just ask that you return the envelope with the designated amount of money (\$1-\$100) to the church office or to myself (Zachary Littleton). Raising funds can be an overwhelming task but if we can get 100 donations in the amounts written on the envelopes that you choose, when the WOM is finished and there are no more envelopes, we will have raised over \$5,000, roughly half of our total camp costs each year.
