In Acts 6, Stephen is nabbed and brought before the Jewish leaders. Acts 7 is his defense sermon that spans 53 verses. You thought I was long-winded! His Spirit-led sermon was so convicting that his enemies stoned him to death. Seeing that Jerusalem rejected the Gospel, the Spirit led the witnesses to the Samaritans! Philip the evangelist, not the apostle, must have thought it was foolish to leave the crowds of people in Samaria to go to a desert in Gaza, but he trusted God's wisdom. We too should trust the wisdom of God over our human understanding. *God puts us in the right place at the right time to be His witness. Trust His wisdom.*
