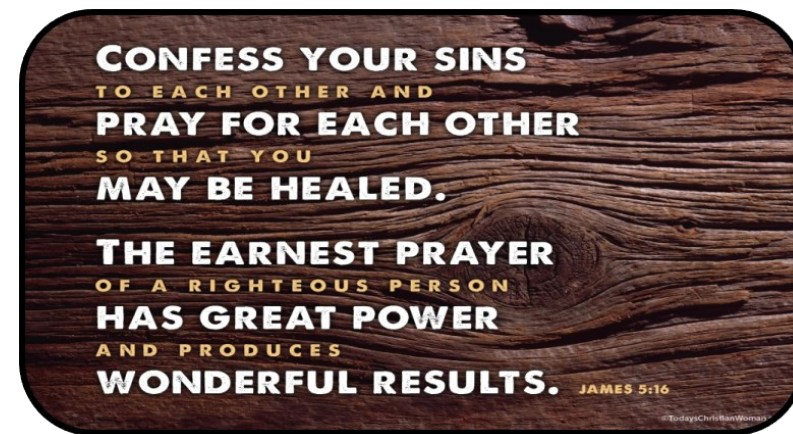

Prayer is certainly the theme of these verses. It is mentioned in every verse but 19 and 20. I like to think that James now shows us the proper and righteous use of the tongue.
